

Mac / PC: Keyboard shortcuts—similarities and differences →

Mac	PC
shift	shift
⌘ (command)	control
option	alt

ZOOM In & Out:

- Zoom Tool (use Option key for Zoom-Out)
- ⌘ Command / Control and (+ or -) key
- Double-Click on the Zoom Tool (Z) to go to 100%
- Double-Click on the Hand Tool (H) to fit image to screen size
- Spacebar + ⌘ Command / Control key = Zoom In (add Option key for Zoom Out)
- Navigator panel

Selection Tools:

- Marquee Tool (rectangular, elliptical)
- Move Tool (Check: Auto Select –and– Show Transform Controls)
- Lasso (regular, polygonal, magnetic)
- Magic Wand / Quick Selection tool

ADD or **SUBTRACT** from a selection (using Shift or Option / Alt)

Keyboard Shortcuts: (all using the ⌘ Command / Control key)

- ⌘ Z (Undo) ⌘ C (Copy) ⌘ S (Save)
- ⌘ A (Select All) ⌘ X (Cut)
- ⌘ D (Deselect) ⌘ V (Paste)

Transformations: Edit > Transform –or– Free Transform (⌘ T)
scale, rotate, skew, distort, perspective, warp, flip

Layers: Adding, deleting, locking, duplicating, linking, and rearranging

Opacity: Adjusting transparency for each layer in the Layers Panel

Duplicating: Drag a **COPY** of an image / object: (Option /Alt + drag)

Colorizing: Image > Adjustments > Hue / Saturation > Colorize

Snapping: View > **Snap** OFF (unchecked)

Liquify: Filter > Liquify

Photoshop file formats: .psd and .jpg (compare: sizes, layers, opacity)
